

Annual Report

Burdwan Sadar Pyara Nutrition Welfare Society is a leading NGO of West Bengal working mainly in Burdwan District as well as in nearby district. The society is working on two specific dimensions that is: 1. Community Development 2. Awareness Campaigning

1. **Community Development:** For a sustainable development of community society is working hard in the three arena of development. These sectors are:
 - a. **Health & Nutrition:** Society members are engaged all through the year for the development of vulnerable groups by means their nutritional development and where necessary providing nutrition support to the common people. The society measures nutritional status of slum area children by Anthropometric measurement procedure and when necessary organizes “Annaprashan” (Rice Ceremony) for SAM & MAM children in order to recover their nutritional status. The society supports those children by donating protein and carbohydrate rich foods such as Soya bean, Pulses, Suji etc. The Society also adopts pregnant mothers to ensure the birth of children with adequate birth weight and decreases the chances the birth of LBW child. The society also supports woman with poor health status and distressed elderly people by providing nutritional support. The society also provides spot feeding to the beggars. In the summer society offers packaged drinking water & ORS to pedestrians to prevent heat related complications.
In the field of health, the society organizes health camps with private & Govt. Hospitals for detecting actual health status of the people and whenever necessary tries to support either financially or by sending those people to Govt. Hospitals for better treatment. For the development of mental health status of elderly and younger people the society organizes pandel hopping during Durga Puja Festival and annual picnic at the year end.
 - b. **Expansion of Education:** In order to expand the arena of education society is engaged in developing educational support system in the marginal area of South Bengal and trying to build up educational hub in collaboration with different existing clubs by donating them educational materials such as books, pen, chalk, duster, board, drawing tools, shades & monetary support. Society also gives scholarship to the poor meritorious students under the project “Utsaho” (encourage)
 - c. **Sustainable development of Environment:** In order to preserve our nature and environment the society is engaged in the destruction of poisonous parthenium and construction of local flora by afforestation. In new plantation the society always gives privilege to local flora and plants with economic benefits & medicinal benefits. The society is also engaged to make the Purba Bardhaman district plastic free and tries to clean up the banks of river and ponds. To maintain our environmental health the society has expanded its project “Shyamalima” (Greenery) to the school campuses

and engaged forty-five students as green volunteer who will be awarded with scholarship according to their performances.

2. Woman empowerment: In order to empower woman, the society continues Karate coaching camps at different slum areas and to support women to become financially stable.
3. Awareness Campaigning: In order to make a sustainable growth it is essential to aware the people of the community about the common problems of present situation as well as the problems of future to be faced by the community. Hence the society always tries to aware people in the following issues:
 - a. Health & Nutrition Awareness: The society arranges diet camps to aware people about non communicable diseases and life style regulation with healthy dietary practices. The society also celebrated different health related important days with poster banners and also celebrates National Nutrition Month to promote Indian tradition foods and their health benefits. The society also celebrates National Food Safety Day to vote for food safety and to aware people about hygienic means of food handling.
 - b. Educational Awareness: The society aware people about consumer affairs and fair trade policies and also about safe banking practices. The society also always aware people about cybercrime. The society also educates students about health & environment related issues by organizing seminars in different schools.
 - c. Environmental Awareness: The society celebrates different environment related days such as World Earth Day, World Water Day etc. by arranging rallies, webinars, and displaying charts, posters etc. by promotional vehicles.
 - d. Awareness on woman empowerment: The society always aware girls and woman about cybercrime & human trafficking by organizing “Swayamsiddha” camp. The society also tries to prevent childhood marriage.
